Who We Are?

We are a private residential short stay recovery unit that provides care to people who are fit for discharge but require additional support before going back home, this could include but not limited to physical health issues, palliative care needs etc.

We know that staying in hospital is a very worrying time for anyone and going home without additional support can also be worrying.

Everyone staying with us will receive personalised care, tailored to their individual needs. They'll have their own furnished room, be welcomed into the home and be supported towards independence.

Our home is based in Boston, Lincolnshire and is within easy reach of the A16 and Boston train station, main town which makes it nice and convenient for friends and family to visit.



Benefits of Short Stay

A short period with us could reduce hospital bed blocking, the risk of hospital acquired infections, increase patient satisfaction, yield more efficient use of treatment beds and promotes continuity of care outside the hospital environment.

During a client's stay with us, the referrer will help assess longer-term ongoing health and care needs, together with the multi-disciplinary team they will decide how this care will be funded and let clients know whether they will need to contribute towards the cost of care.

Social inclusion- Friends and relatives can visit client's, we have a conservatory area and another quiet room separate from the main house where you can relax with your loved ones daily between 09:00-16:

Clients may also choose to self-refer from the community. We also provide support to clients with mild mental health problems who are on their recovery journey.

What to expect from Pilgrimage short stay recovery service (PSSRU)?

- Before a person is discharged from a place of treatment, staff will discuss their needs then agree with the patient their recovery process, support plan and risk management plan, which might include any equipment you may need. Staff may feel that a patient's needs may benefit from professionals outside a hospital setting and they may refer patients to us for further support or waiting to go to a Care Home.
- At PSSRU we follow a client's hospital discharge plan. Our short stay recovery unit aims to enhance our client's recovery and enable them to return home safely and competently.
- On arrival at the unit, clients will receive a plan for the duration of their stay, which will be informed by their hospital discharge. Our aim is to help clients recover from their physical health challenges and regain independence in a comfortable environment.
- There is good evidence that recuperating from illness with professional support will enable clients to have good control of their capability which helps to speed up recovery. Clients will be involved in their care planning from admission and throughout their stay to ensure a positive and safe recovery and discharge back in the community.
